### Digital Citizenship

"No matter who or where we are, when we are online we're all digital citizens... and what we can do can have a big influence on everyone else!"

One of the key phrases important to this weeks training is...

### Digital Footprint

This is the trail information that exists about you from your individual online activity.

You have an **active** footprint left by the things you post or share knowingly, i.e. on social media.

There is also a **passive** footprint that can be made up of your browsing habits, and may be created without your consent or knowledge



There are a total of 6 tips Telstra provides for adults and parents about your digital footprint... This includes 'Look into yourself', where it asks you to type your name into a search engine.
