

Staying Safe Online Some helpful tips







Whether at the library, at home or out and about, follow these tips to make sure you stay safe online.

**Use strong passwords** including a combination of numbers, upper and lower case letters and symbols if possible.

Familiarise yourself with the privacy settings of social networking sites that you use.

Keep your mobile device with you at all times and locked with a PIN.

Only make online purchases from companies with secure payment pages. Look for 'https' or an image of a padlock in the address bar.

Take extra care of your USB/flash drives particularly if yours has personal information (such as a resume) saved to it.

Do not share your passwords or PINs with anyone.

Only use a trusted, encrypted network if using WiFi for shopping, banking or sending personal information.
