Domain 4

Effective teacher practices – teachers use and model techniques that encourage positive peer relationships that enhance wellbeing and to help prevent the development of all bullying and other negative behaviours.

Domain 5

An eSmart curriculum – explicitly teaches about rights and responsibilities, awareness of bullying, social and emotional skills, digital literacy and citizenship. It teaches about the smart, safe and responsible uses of technology and identifies where and how these are taught.

Domain 6

Partnerships with parent and the local community – a range of education opportunities are provided to parents, including information on bullying, social learning and the smart safe and responsible use of digital technology.
