2019 Rules

Annual Mini Putt Business House Challenge

These are the rules set forth by Prodrive Golf for this Tournament

Welcome to Prodrive Golf's 18 Hole Mini Putt Golf Course, the OBJECT of Mini Golf is to get the ball in the hole using the LEAST amount of strokes.

The format for this competition is Foursomes where you compete in teams of two, using one ball, one putter, and taking alternate shots until the hole is completed. Team members also take turns in teeing off on each hole, i.e. one player will take the tee shot on odd-numbered holes, and the other on even-numbered holes.

The team that has the outright lowest combined total will be crowned the winner of the event. In the event of a tie there will be a Sudden Death playoff starting from the 1st Hole, a Team must select a Pairing to compete in the playoff. e.g. - The tied participants play one extra hole at a time, with those still tied for the lowest score moving on to the next hole until a winner has been determined.

Who hits first?

Decide amongst your group the order on the first hole. After that, typically, the person who scored lowest on the previous hole has "Honors" (hits first). If no one scored lower on the previous hole, use the same order you used last.

Who hits first after teeing off?

After all have teed off, whoever is FARTHEST from the hole is the first to hit. This continues until the hole is completed.

Out of Bounds – balls leaving the putting area

If you hit your ball too hard and it bounces OFF the putting area, you must replace the ball from where you played with a penalty of one, e.g. - Your Tee shot goes off course or into a Water Hazard, then you must replace the ball from where you played with a penalty of 1 which will mean the next putt played will be your 3rd Stroke.

Ball comes to rest against wall/obstacle

You may Place the ball approximately one putter head width away from the wall/obstacle to take Relief.

Scoring

Please keep track of your strokes accurately. One person in your group will be in charge of writing down the scores.
