Topics can include, but are not limited to:

- the challenges of being a public interest law student;
- diversity and inclusion in legal aid and indigent defense;
- recent news headlines relevant to public interest law practice areas;
- law school and community organizing;
- the areas of public interest law that need most attention right now;
- public interest law jobs, internships, and fellowships; and more!

The winner will be recognized for his or her exceptional writing ability and for creating captivating content that speaks to the law school audience. Submissions will be graded by the National Advisory Committee Blog Post Competition Working Group Members based on the following factors:

- Compelling content
- Organization
- Creativity/originality
- Grammar and writing style
