# How to install the ArcGIS 10.1 Licence Manager



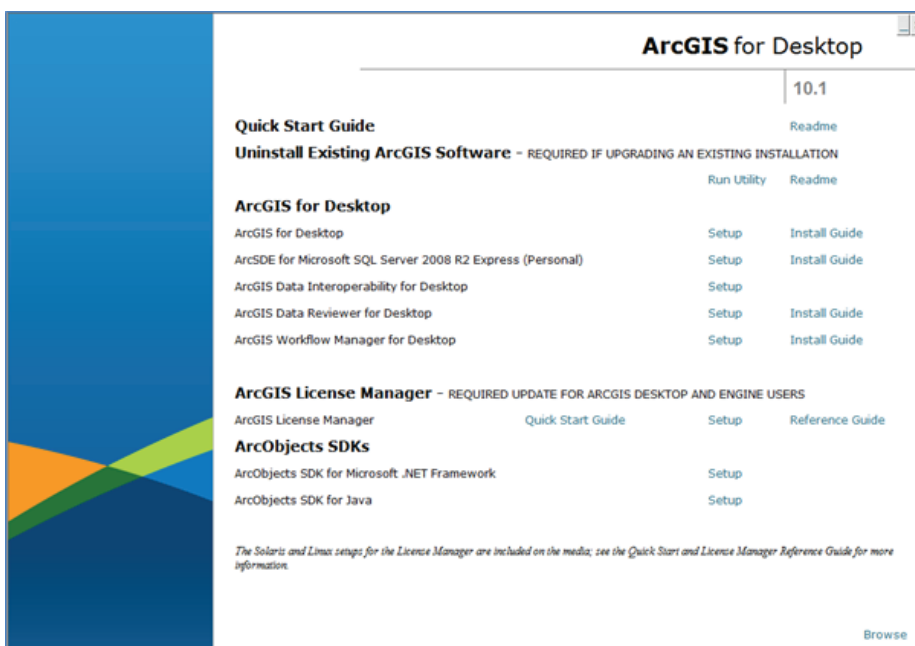
If you are using Concurrent Use licences for your Desktop products you will need to install the Licence Manager, or have access to a Licence Manager which is up and running. This document walks through the process of installing the 10.1 Licence Manager on Windows.

### A note on 10.0 and 10.1 concurrent licencing

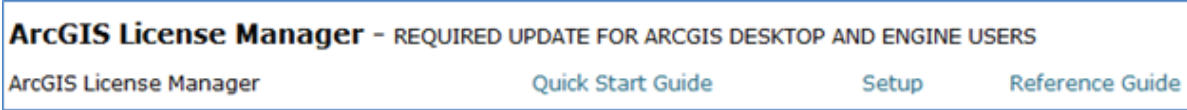
The 10.1 Licence Manager will support hosting 9.0 up to and including 10.1 licences. This means that if you are working in a hybrid environment with older versions and 10.1 desktop machines, you do not need to install both Licence Managers and have the running together. Please uninstall the 10.0 Licence Manager and install the 10.1 Licence Manager. To avoid disrupting your concurrent use licence users, you may wish to install the 10.1 Licence Manager on a second machine to allow them to continue working during the upgrade. Once the upgrade is complete, any older versions of the Licence Manager must be uninstalled and users directed to the new 10.1. Licence Manager.

### Installing the ArcGIS 10.1 Licence Manager on Windows

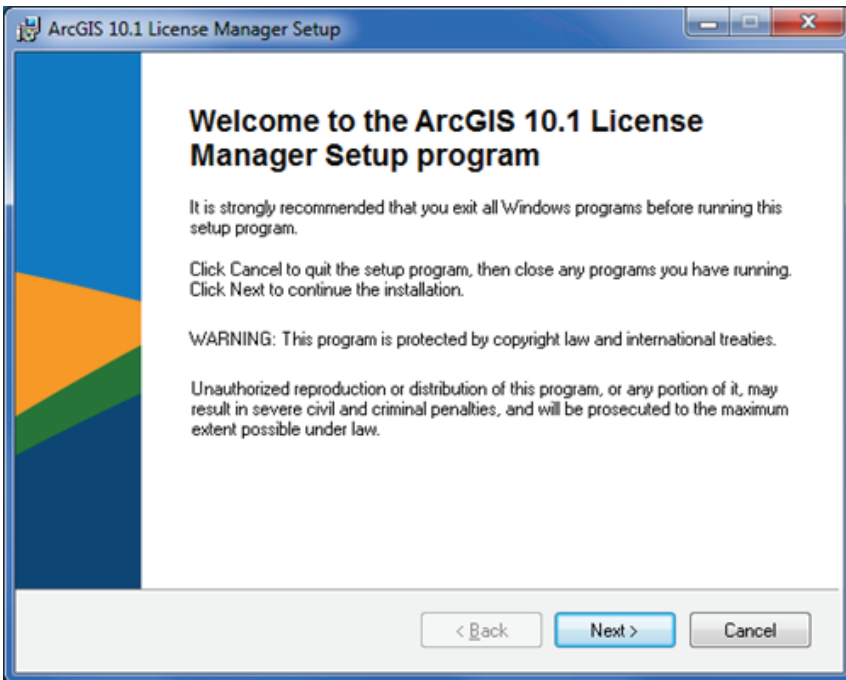
1. Navigate to the Desktop install media folder and run **Esri.exe**.



2. Click on the **Setup** for the ArcGIS Licence Manager.

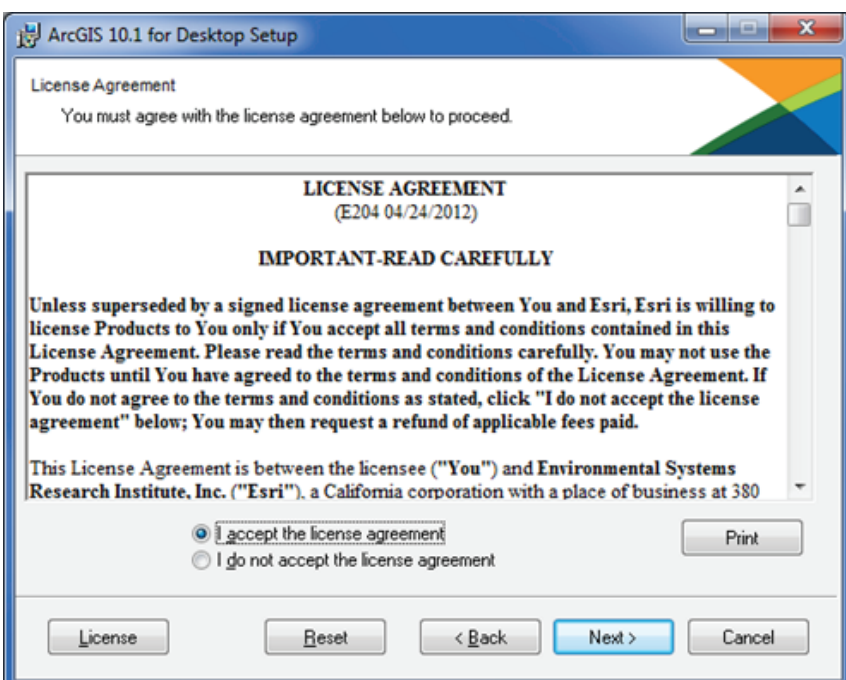


The Welcome screen displays.



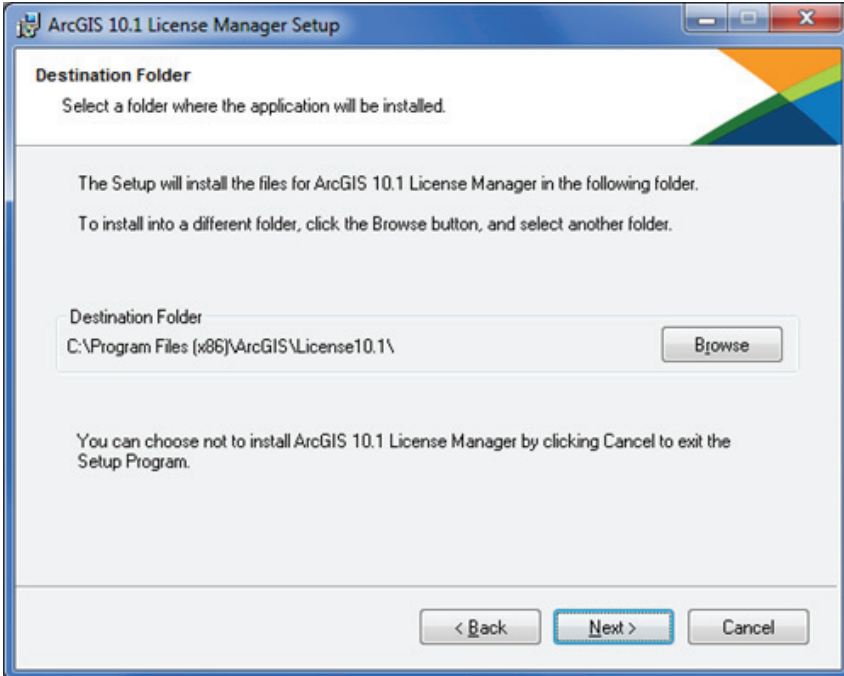
Click **Next**.

3. Click the radio button next to **I accept the license agreement**

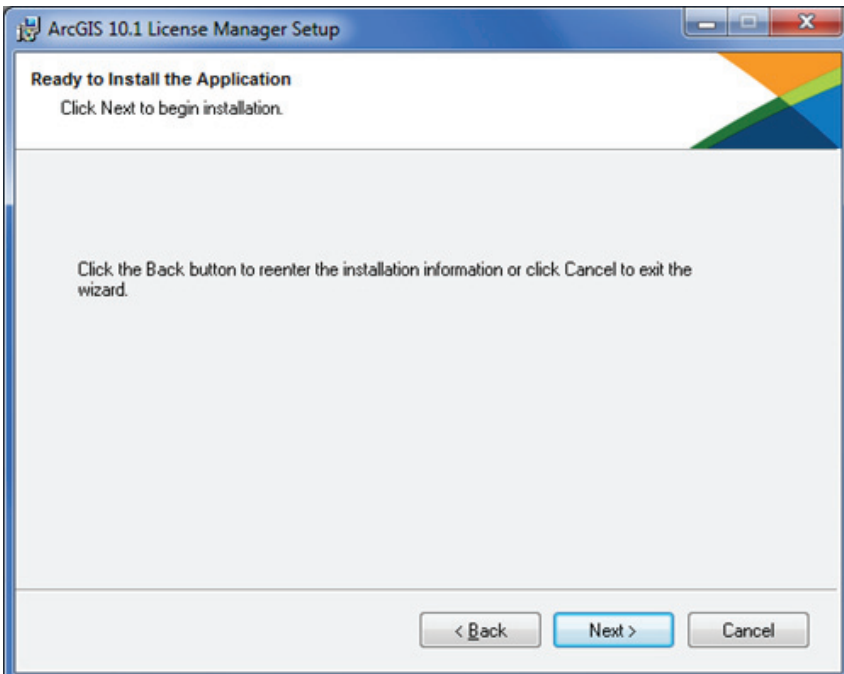


Click **Next**

4. Accept the default destination folder or choose your own.

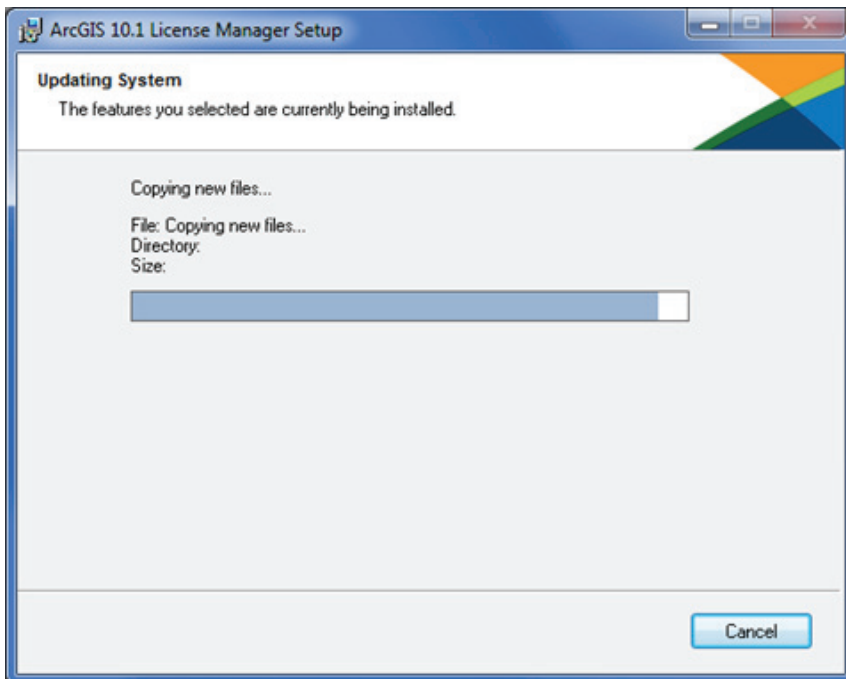


5. The **Ready to Install the Application** screen displays.

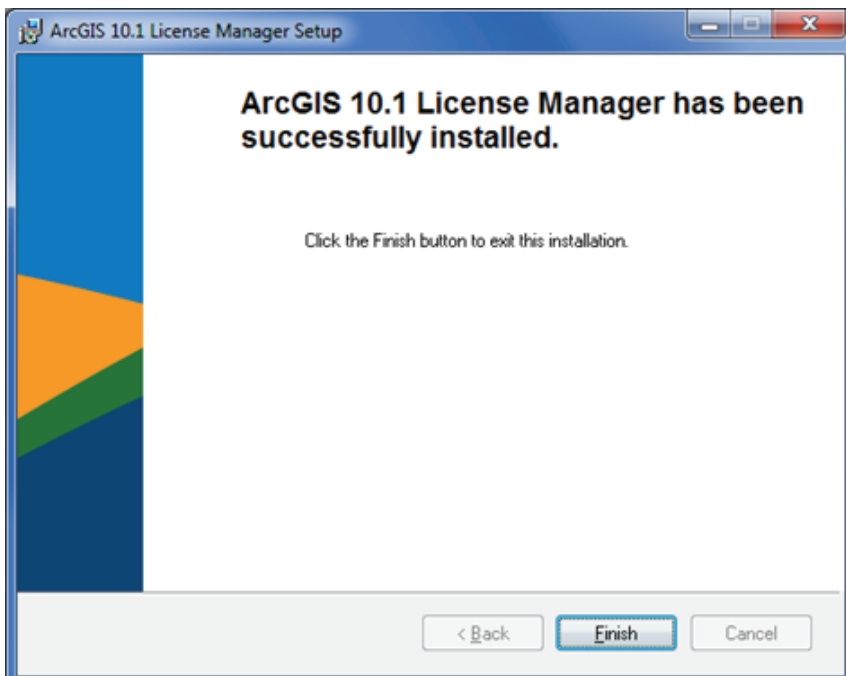


Click **Next**

6. The Licence Manager will be installed.



You will see a screen telling you that the installation has been successful.



Click **Finish**

7. Next, the ArcGIS Licence Server Administrator – 10.1 screen will display. This is where you can manage your Concurrent Use products and extensions. Notice in the bottom left corner that the Licence Server Status is RUNNING.
