Focus Areas:

- Emergency Management is defined as a core member of a successful HCC.
- HCCs can be a central point for connecting Hospitals, EMS, Public Health, and other health care partners, to Emergency Management.
- When health care networks transcend normal geographic or political boundaries HCCs can help them navigate the local or state emergency management processes.
- HCCs can be a coordinating point for local and regional planning, training, and exercising prior to an event.
- During response and recovery, an HCC can support areas such as staffing, situational awareness and information sharing, and resource coordination.
