



Drew is a Vice President and Senior Risk Consultant of Organizational Resilience in the Risk Services Division. He has over 20 years of experience in the US govt., public and the private sectors regarding crisis management, security, business continuity, emergency management in national, theater, and global risk management. Mr. Bowman has provided security consulting services in over 20 countries, to include special events such as the World Cricket Games and foreign elections.

Prior to joining HUB, Mr. Bowman, a veteran, former US Army Infantry and Special Forces Officer, provided consultation on two multi-million dollar US govt. contracts supporting the US Army and the US Department of State (DoS). These programs included developing national and regional security strategies for the countries of Niger and Chad. Prior to this effort he was an Operational Advisor (OA) for the US Army's Asymmetric Warfare Group (AWG) located at Ft. Meade, MD. As an OA, Drew worked with US Army personnel in developing regional security efforts, humanitarian assistance programs, information operations and host nation military modernization in the Horn of Africa (Djibouti) and Ukraine. Mr. Bowman was also involved in conducting Level II Vulnerability Assessments (L2VA) for military facilities and offensive and defensive cyber capabilities development for the organization.

Prior to joining AWG, Drew spent considerable time in Afghanistan working with US Army and North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) forces in an attempt to better understand the conflict, adapt to changing and emerging enemy strategies and to develop unique solutions to complex problem-sets. As a Counterinsurgency (COIN) Advisor, Drew worked his way up to the lead COIN advisor to the Commander of all International Security Forces Afghanistan (ISAF) developing and evaluating tactical, operational and strategic security and training and plans for host nation, international and US troops.

Drew worked with the US Department of State, Diplomatic Security Service, Anti-Terrorism Assistance Program where he assisted partner countries in enhancing national level services related to critical incident management, vital infrastructure security, diplomatic protection, interdicting terrorist activity, response to hazardous materials incidents for mass casualty events. This includes supporting major global events such as the World Cricket Games in Jamaica.

In previous roles, Drew was instrumental in developing various crisis and security management plans and training for large corporations, and public entertainment venues. In 2002, he provided leadership in security management, threat assessments and executive protection with WorldCom during one of the largest bankruptcies in US history. He also developed training programs and provided security consulting prior to and during the grand opening of the American Airlines Center in Dallas, Texas.
