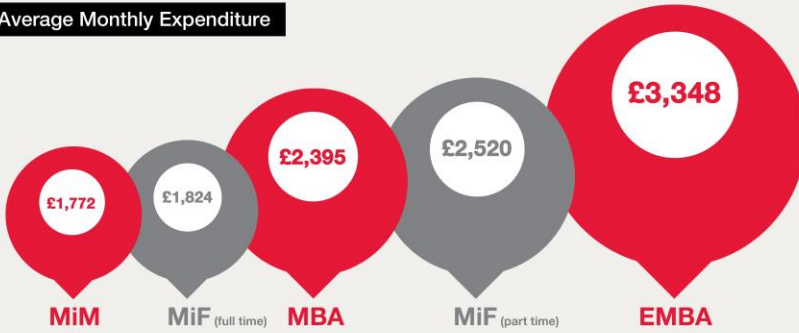


Living in London

During the summer of 2013 London Business School conducted extensive research amongst our London-based students to determine what their average monthly cost of living in the capital was. We asked all students to list their average monthly expenditure on rent, utilities, travel (within London), study materials and eating out etc and the final results per programme are below. These figures simply indicate how much the typical London Business School student spent on average: they do not imply that YOU will necessarily need to spend identical amounts. The figures are also not indicative of a 'minimum' amount required to live in London (i.e. your own personal spending may of course be much less than the below figures).

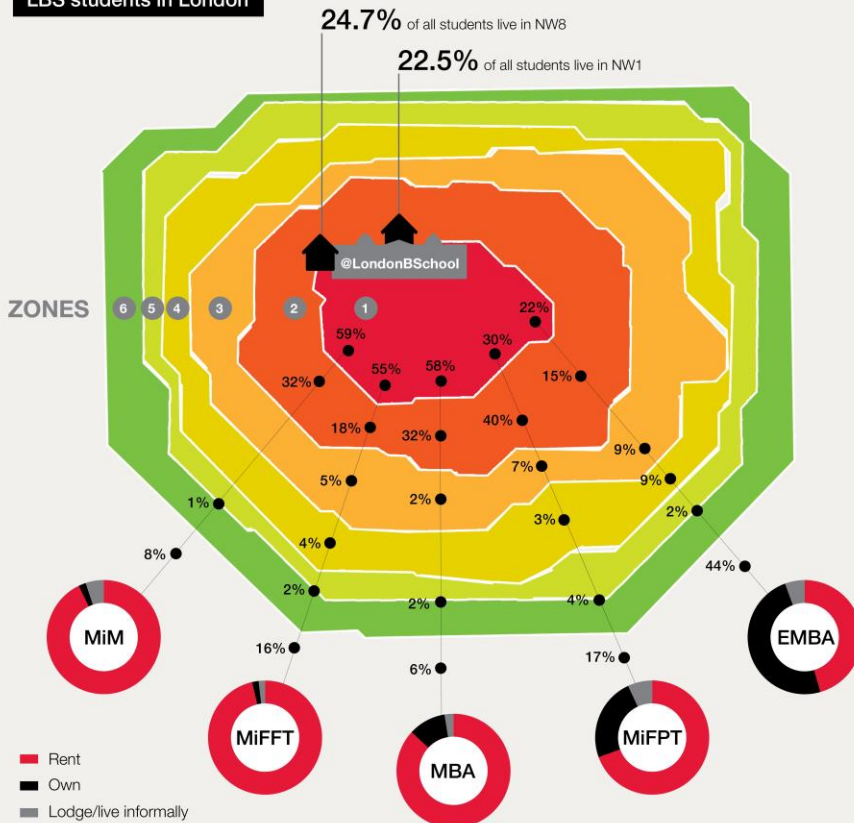
Average Monthly Expenditure
