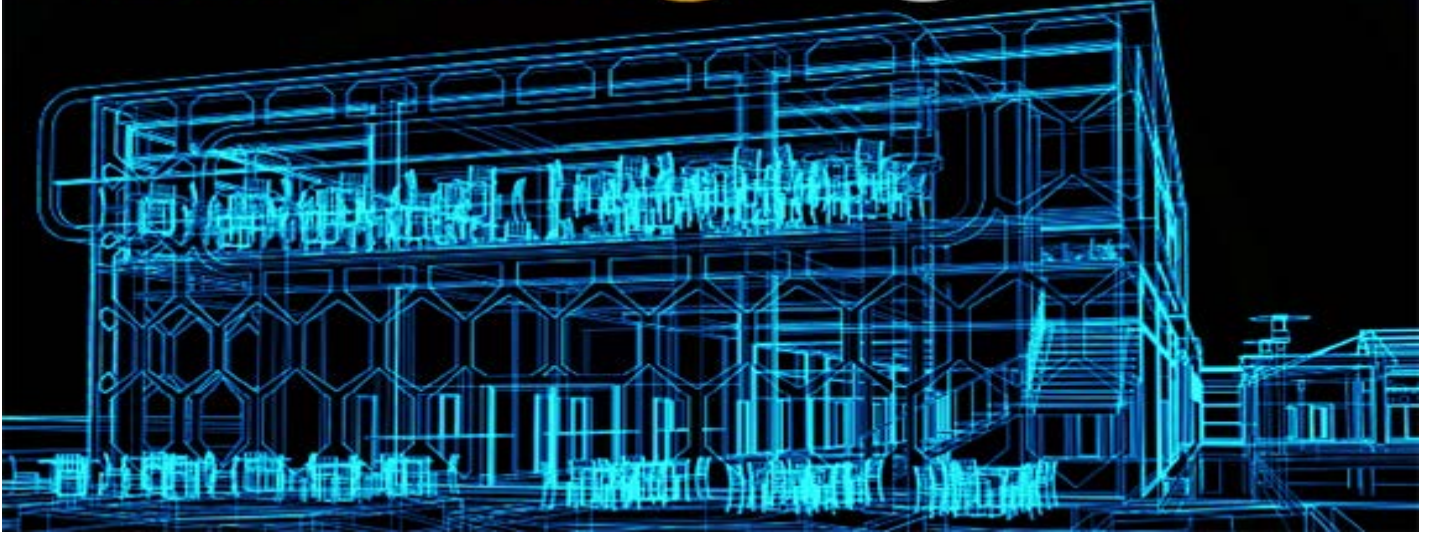


SCU Young Engineers
